Holy Week approaches!

We began Lent with the stark reminder of our own mortality on Ash Wednesday. I've been encouraged by the conversations I've been involved in and overheard in various circles of our church. Many of you are asking great questions, committing yourselves to the Lenten disciplines, and engaging in this process with sincerity and integrity. I know it's not a big, fun party, but it's immensely helpful to us as we seek to be transformed more and more into the image of Jesus Christ, our Savior.

Now we approach the end of our journey together, and it gets much worse before it gets better. You know that saying "it's always darkest before the dawn?" Well, it may not always apply, but it does here. Good Friday is the darkest day of the church year. Youth Report


- 1. The youth group is planning a Family Fun Night on Feb. 10, 2019.






